war and strikes risks – rates & premium – revised 16 April 2009



The availability of cover against War and Strikes risks is determined by reference to the Risk Level shown in the JCC Cargo Watch List, at www.exclusive-analysis.com/cargo.

Unless inclusive rates or in-full premiums are shown in your NMu cargo policy schedule, the basic additional rate for War and Strikes risks cover for shipments to or from locations covered by your policy is 0.05%.

Where covered, shipments to or from locations for which the Risk Level is "Elevated" or "High" may be subject to a surcharge rate or premium¹
